STOPPING UP OR DIVERSION ORDER REFERENCE: The Eastleigh Borough Council (Fair Oak and Horton Heath Footpaths 702 & 703) Diversion Order 2022 ("the Order")

This Order is made by Eastleigh Borough Council under section 257 of the TCPA 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpaths to which this Order relates in order to enable development described in Schedule One to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the TCPA 1990 by the Council on 29 September 2022 under reference F/21/91185.

BY THIS ORDER

- 1. The footpaths over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map 1 and map 2 and described in Part One of Schedule Two to this order shall be diverted as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Eastleigh Borough Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpaths as provided in Part Two of Schedule Two and shown by black dashes on the attached map 1 and map 2.
- 3. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been confirmed is first published in accordance with Part II of Schedule 14 to the TCPA 1990 or the date on which Eastleigh Borough Council has certified that the terms of Article 2 of this Order have been complied with, whichever is the later and may be cited as The Eastleigh Borough Council (Fair Oak and Horton Heath Footpaths 702 & 703) Diversion Order 2022.
- 4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpaths are diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

THE DEVELOPMENT

Construction of road between Allington Lane and Burnetts Lane with associated footway, cycle paths, water crossings, drainage and landscaping.

SCHEDULE TWO

PART ONE

Description of Site of Existing Paths

- 1) An area of highway known as Fair Oak and Horton Heath Footpath 702 being shown as a bold black line between points A and C (a distance of approximately 17.3 metres) as shown on the attached map 1.
- 2) An area of highway known as Fair Oak and Horton Heath Footpath 702 being shown as a bold black line between points C and B (a distance of approximately 484 metres) as shown on the attached map 2.
- 3) An area of highway known as Fair Oak and Horton Heath Footpath 703 being shown as a bold black line between points D and E (a distance of approximately 16 metres) as shown on the attached map 1.

PART TWO

Description of Site of Alternative Highway

- 1) A footpath of the route shown dashed black between points A and B (a distance of approximately 18.5 metres) as shown on the attached map 1.
- 2) A footpath of the route shown dashed black between points A and B (a distance of approximately 480.8 metres) as shown on the attached map 2.
- 3) A footpath of the route shown dashed black between points D and E (a distance of approximately 38 metres) as shown on the attached map 1.

The width of the said alternative highways is a minimum of 2 metres.
