Riverside, Bishopstoke

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 27 October 2016 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
