



THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (BURSLEDON, HAMBLE-LE-RICE AND HOUND) (AMENDMENT NO.6) ORDER 2015

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Amendment Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police.

The general effect of this Order is to insert into The Borough of Eastleigh (Bursledon, Hamble-le-Rice and Hound) Consolidation Order 2012 new waiting restrictions, and revoke some existing restrictions as detailed below:

No waiting at any time

Due to the redevelopment of the Netley Court School new waiting restrictions are required to reflect the changes in road layout. The proposed restrictions ensure pedestrian crossing points are kept clear and sightlines are maintained at junction.

<u>Limited waiting - 30 min no return 1 hour - 8 am to 6 pm – Monday to Friday</u> Limited waiting bay is to be installed near the junction of Chamberlayne Road, this is to encourage vehicle turn over for the shops along Victoria Road.

Loading Bay 9am - 5pm Monday to Saturday Loading Bay to be provided to ensure a safe loading area for delivery vehicles

Disabled Parking bay

A disabled parking bay to be provided for blue badge holders, at present there are no public disabled bays along this section of road.

The Order will come into operation 4 December 2015. A copy of the Order may be inspected at my office at Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh during normal office hours or on the Councils website: www.eastleigh.gov.uk/TRO

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 27 November 2015 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
