Why do we need your personal information?

Who we might share your information with

Your personal information will be treated as confidential, but it may be shared with other Council services in order to ensure our records are accurate and up-to-date and to improve the standard of the services we deliver. We will only use your information in ways which are permitted by the General Data Protection Regulation and the UK Data Protection law.

If we need to talk to other people and organisations regarding your information in the course of conducting our enquiries and assessing your entitlements, we will obtain your consent. Consent is given as part of the declaration that is signed when you complete an application form to make a claim. We would not be able to assess your circumstances and offer the correct advice if this is withheld.

- The Council has a duty to protect the public funds it administers and may use the information you have provided or share it with other bodies for the purpose of preventing and detecting fraud. This includes participation in the Cabinet Office [National Fraud Initiative](#).
- We will NOT use your personal data for marketing products or services.

How long we keep your data

We retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purpose of satisfying any legal, accounting or reporting requirements, or to fulfil statutory obligations.
