## THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (HOUND ROAD, NETLEY) (PARKING RESTRICTION) ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police.

EFFECT OF ORDER: Will, make permanent the Borough of Eastleigh (Hound Road, Netley) Experimental Order 2017 which introduced no waiting at any time restrictions at the southern end of Hound Road, between its junction with Hound Close and the turning head / entrance to RVCP. The intention behind the Order was to gauge whether the restrictions in the Order ease parking congestion, improve access and address road safety concerns in this area and whether, once the impact of the restrictions has been assessed, the Order should be made permanent.

The Order will come into operation on 1 March 2019. Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 8 February 2019 apply to the High Court for this purpose
