Request:

- 1. How much money was your council granted by the Department for Work and Pensions during tranche 2 of the Household Support fund e.g money granted for 1 April 2022 to 30 September 2022?
 - 2. How much money did your council spend of the granted money from tranche 2 e.g money spent 1 April 2022 to 30 September 2022?
 - 3. Where any restrictions placed on how you could spend this money? If so, what were they?

Response:

The DWP allocated the Housing Support Fund budget to the top tier Council e.g. Hampshire County Council. The Local Authorities were allocated a much smaller sum as part of Hampshire County Council's distribution of the money across the county.

1. How much money was your council granted by the Department for Work and Pensions during tranche 2 of the Household Support fund e.g. money granted for 1 April 2022 to 30 September 2022?

1st April – 30th September grant determination letter on 25th May from Hampshire County Council.

- a. Exceptional Housing Fund £46,547
- b. Food voucher scheme -£295,309
- c. Admin costs £17,0932
- 2. How much money did your council spend of the granted money from tranche 2 e.g money spent 1 April 2022 to 30 September 2022? 3. Were any restrictions placed on how you could spend this money? If so, what were they?
- a. Exceptional Housing Fund £26,930.89

Restrictions – It must not replace existing funds e.g. a Discretionary Housing Payment must be considered for rent in advance and rent arrears before Household Support Fund can be considered.

Criteria – One third must be spent on households with pensioners, one third on households with children and no criteria for remaining third.

- b. Food Vouchers £246,950
- c. Admin £18,000

Criteria – for those in receipt of Local Council Tax Support and Pension Credit Guaranteed Credit, the food voucher value is £65 per eligible pensioner and for households in receipt of Local Council Tax Support, the food voucher value is £30 per household.

Restrictions – As the criteria is set by DWP to Hampshire County Council, we cannot be certain what is a DWP restriction and what is an HCC restriction
