Introduced improvements to our waste and recycling collections

Completed the removal of Budgens store and installed a temporary free car park in Hedge End village

Refurbished the toilets at Eastleigh bus station to provide modern and accessible facilities

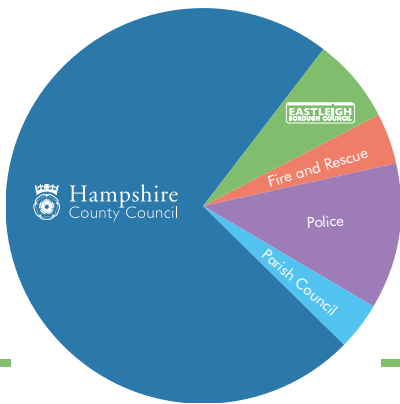
Replaced all our petrol hand tools with electric ones, and trialled electric refuse freighters

SOME OF OUR PLANS FOR THIS YEAR WILL BE TO:



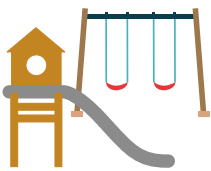
To provide 136 Council funded homes for private rent at Kestrel Park, Bursledon, and North Stoneham Park and Fanfare Place, Eastleigh
