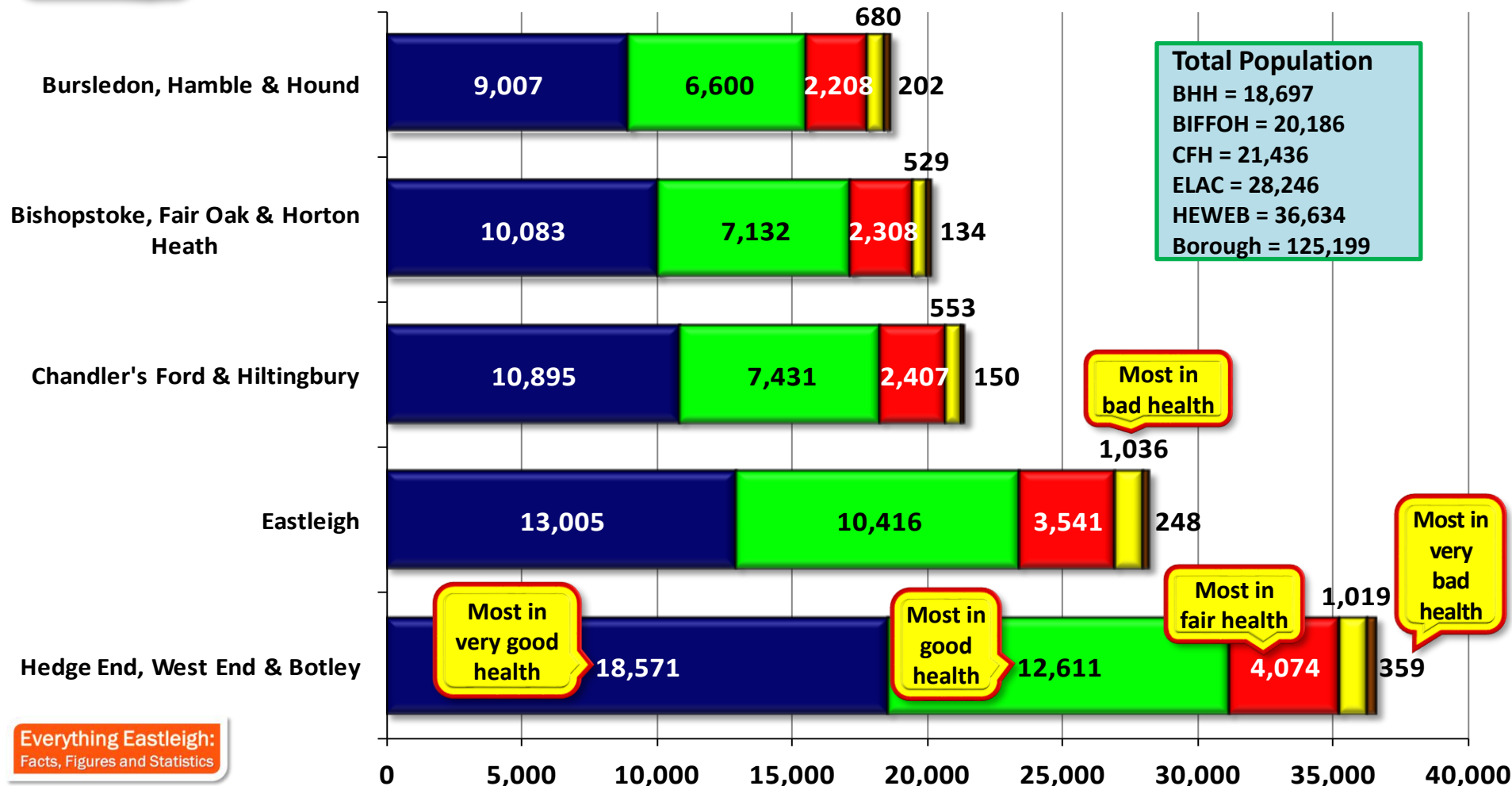

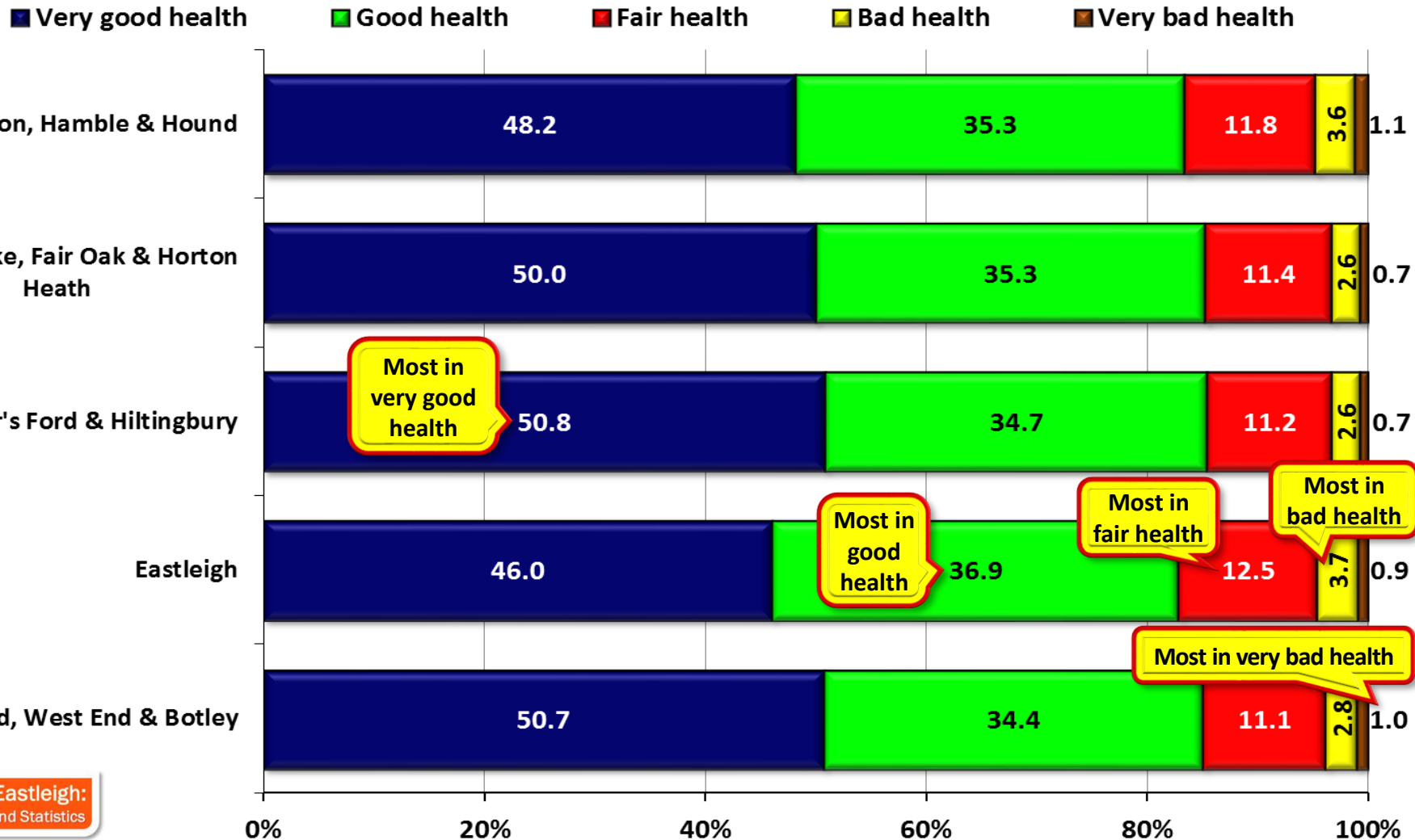

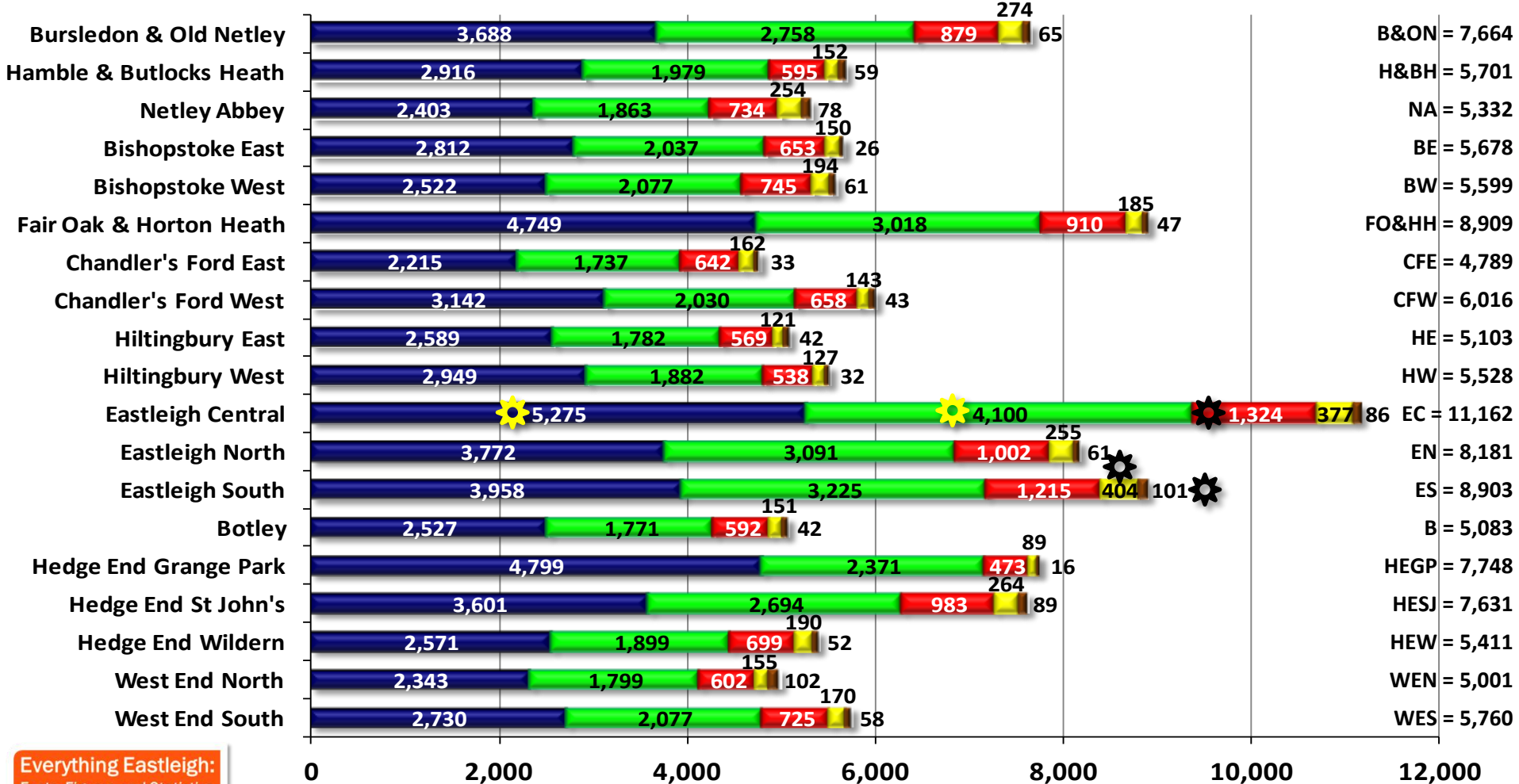

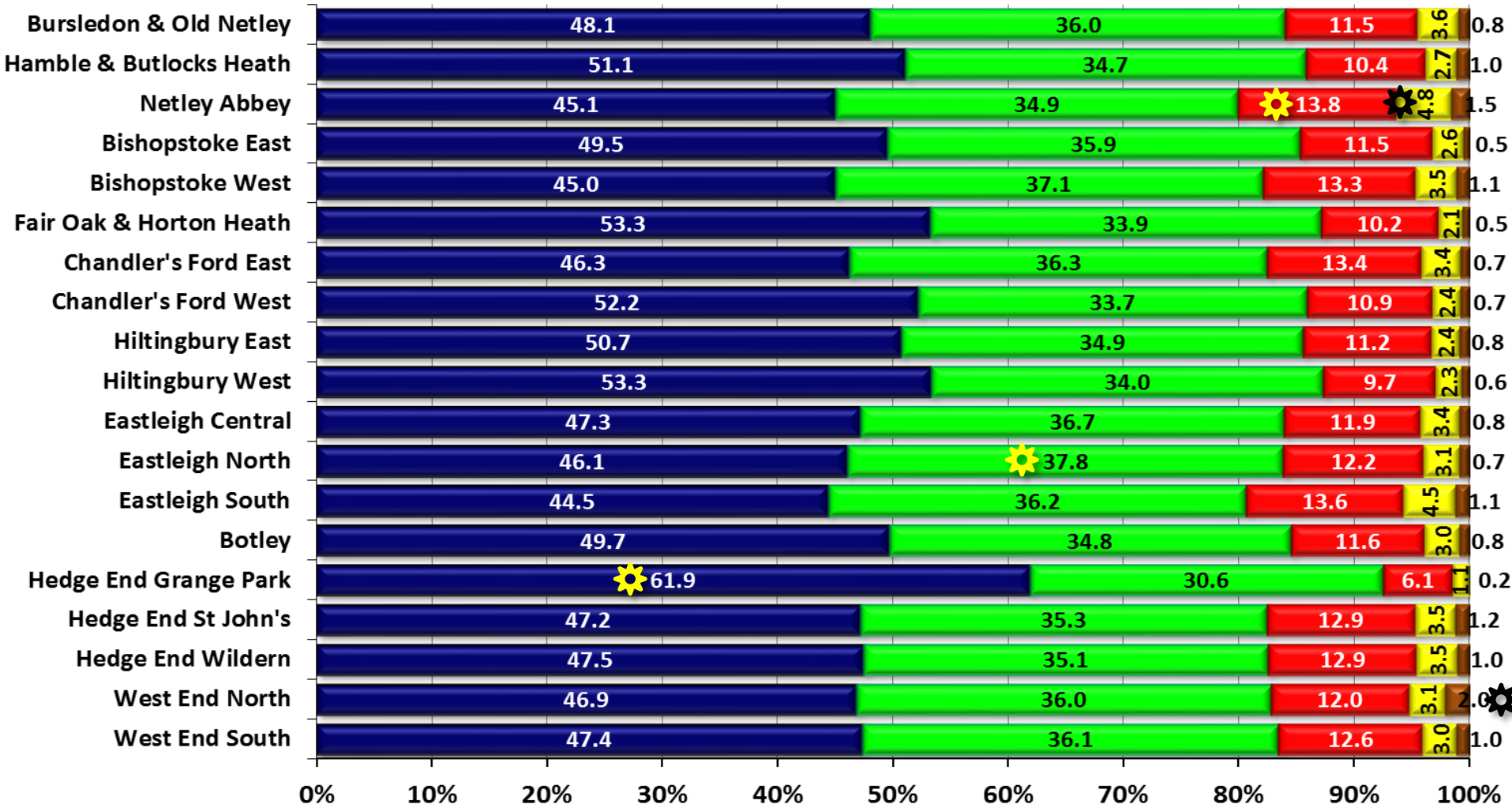

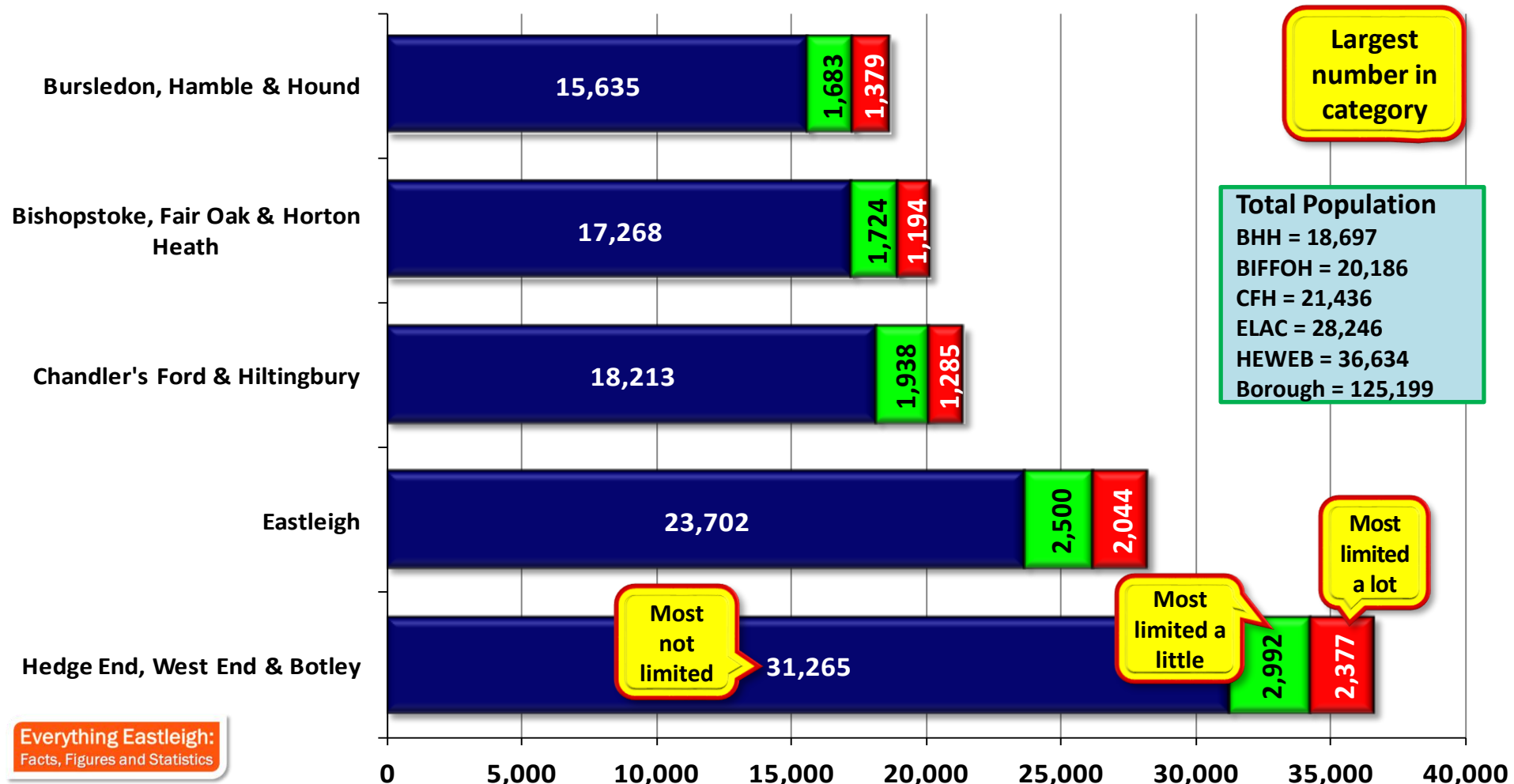


(6.2.1) Limiting Long-term Illness: Local Areas

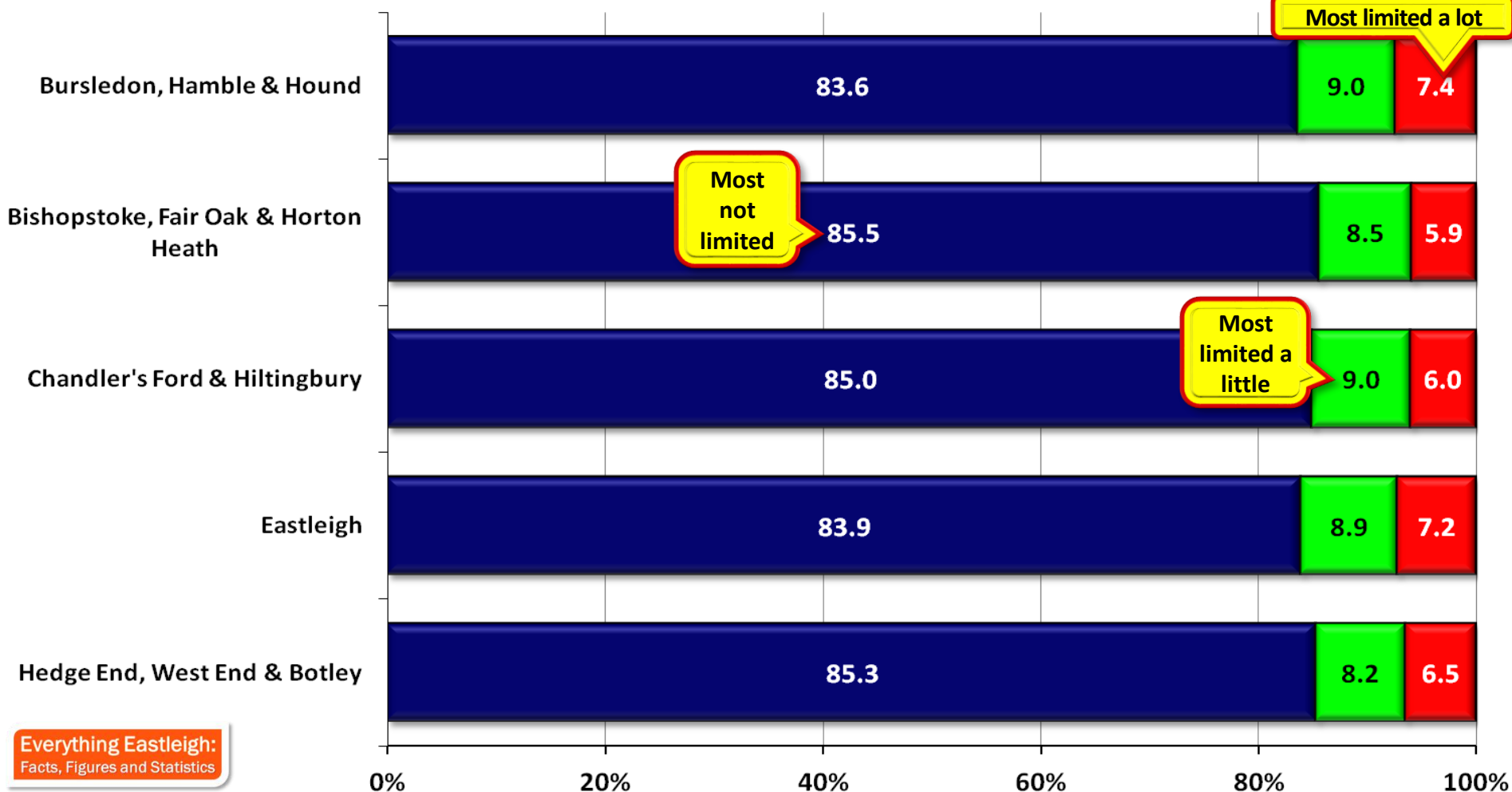

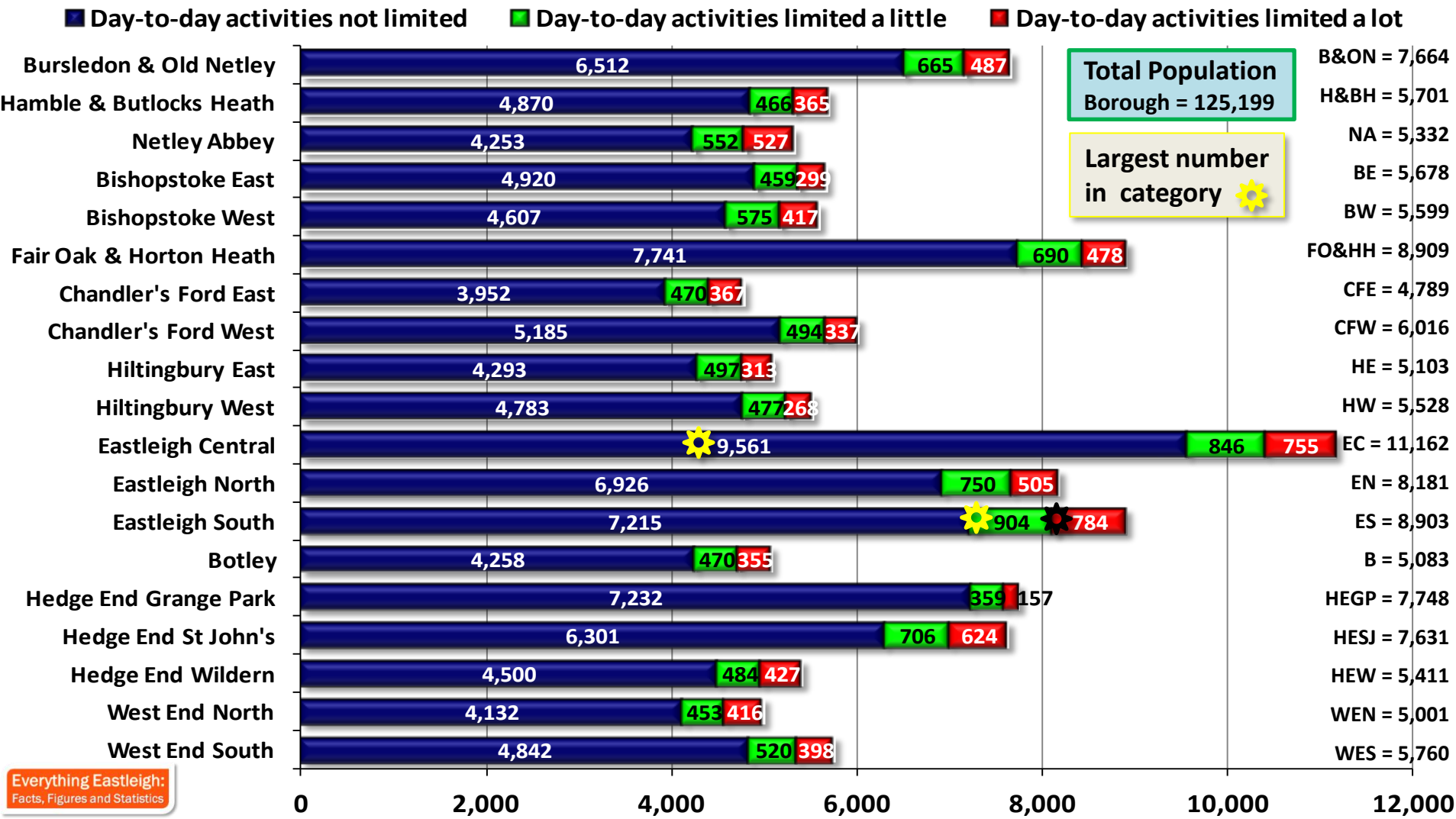

Eastleigh Borough Wards: Limiting Long Term Illness (%) - Census, 2011

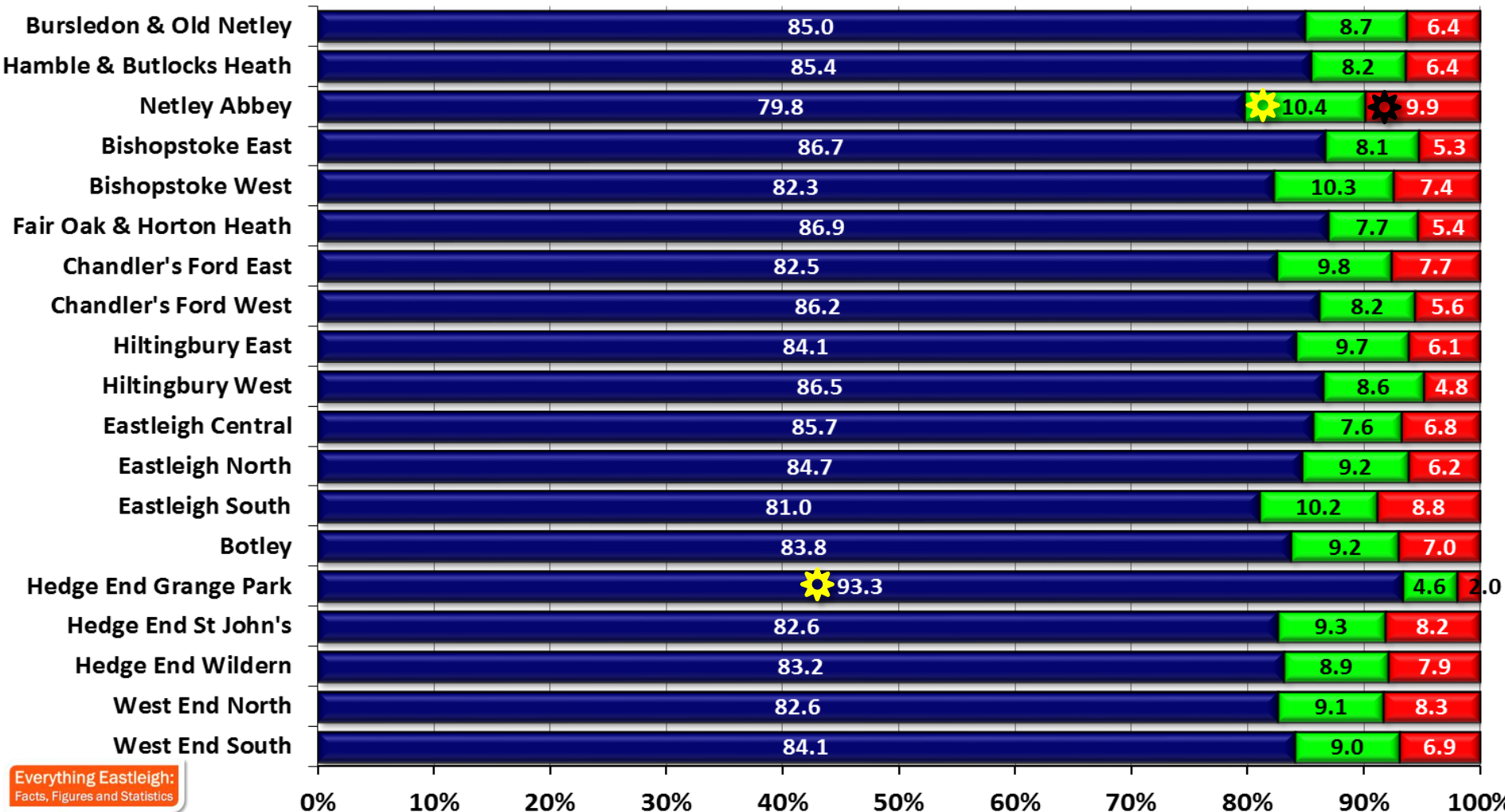

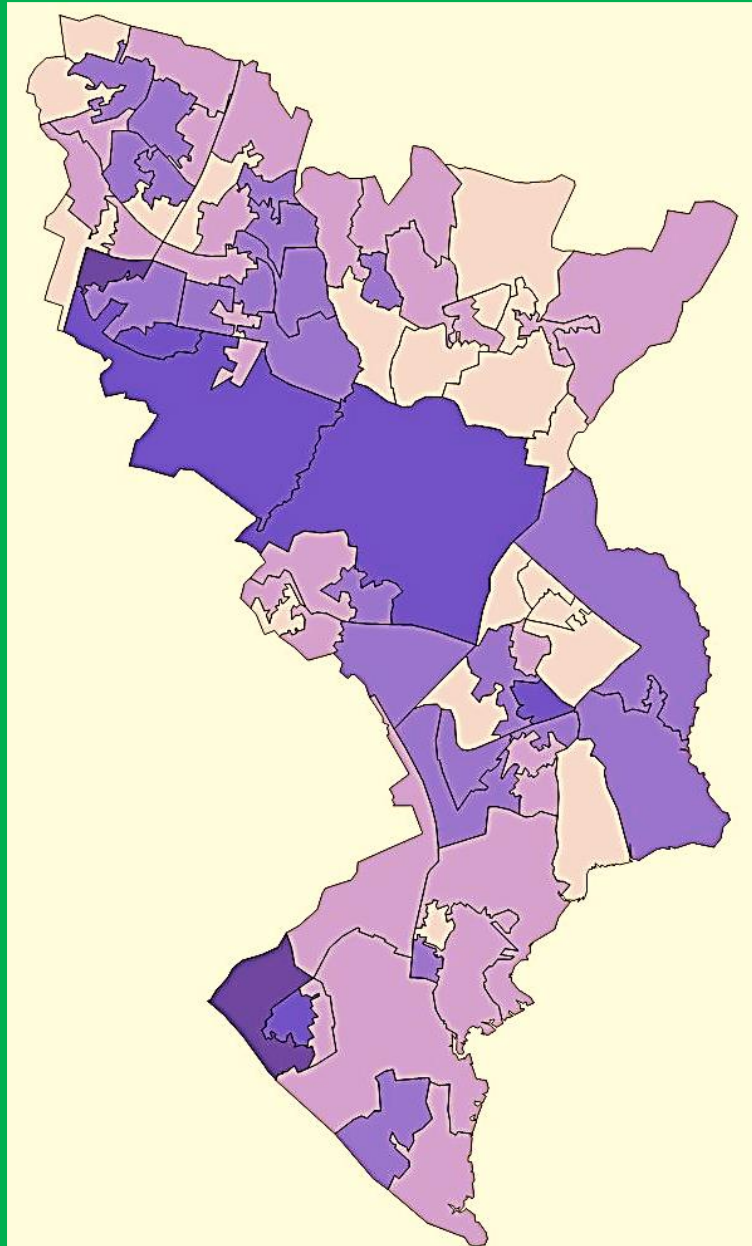

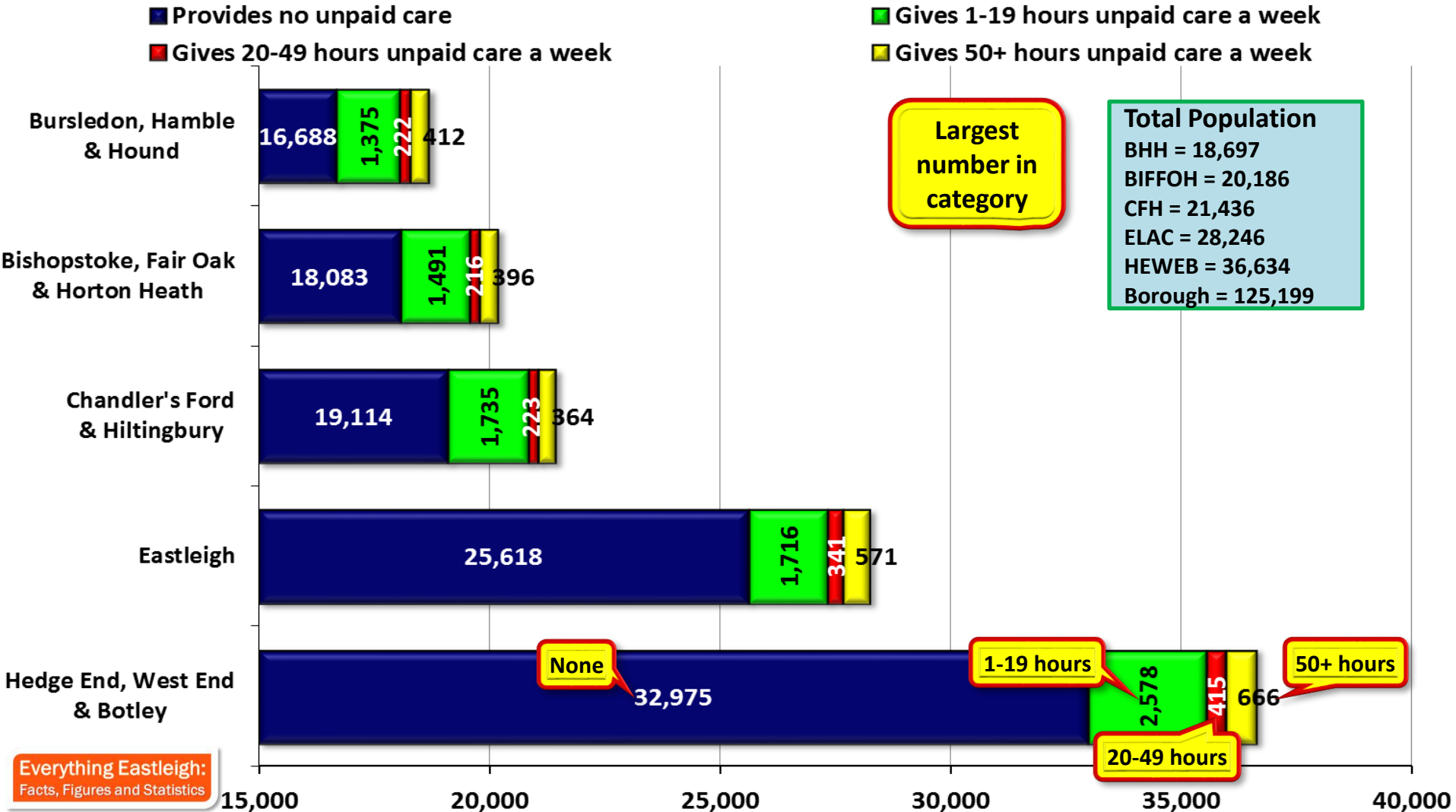

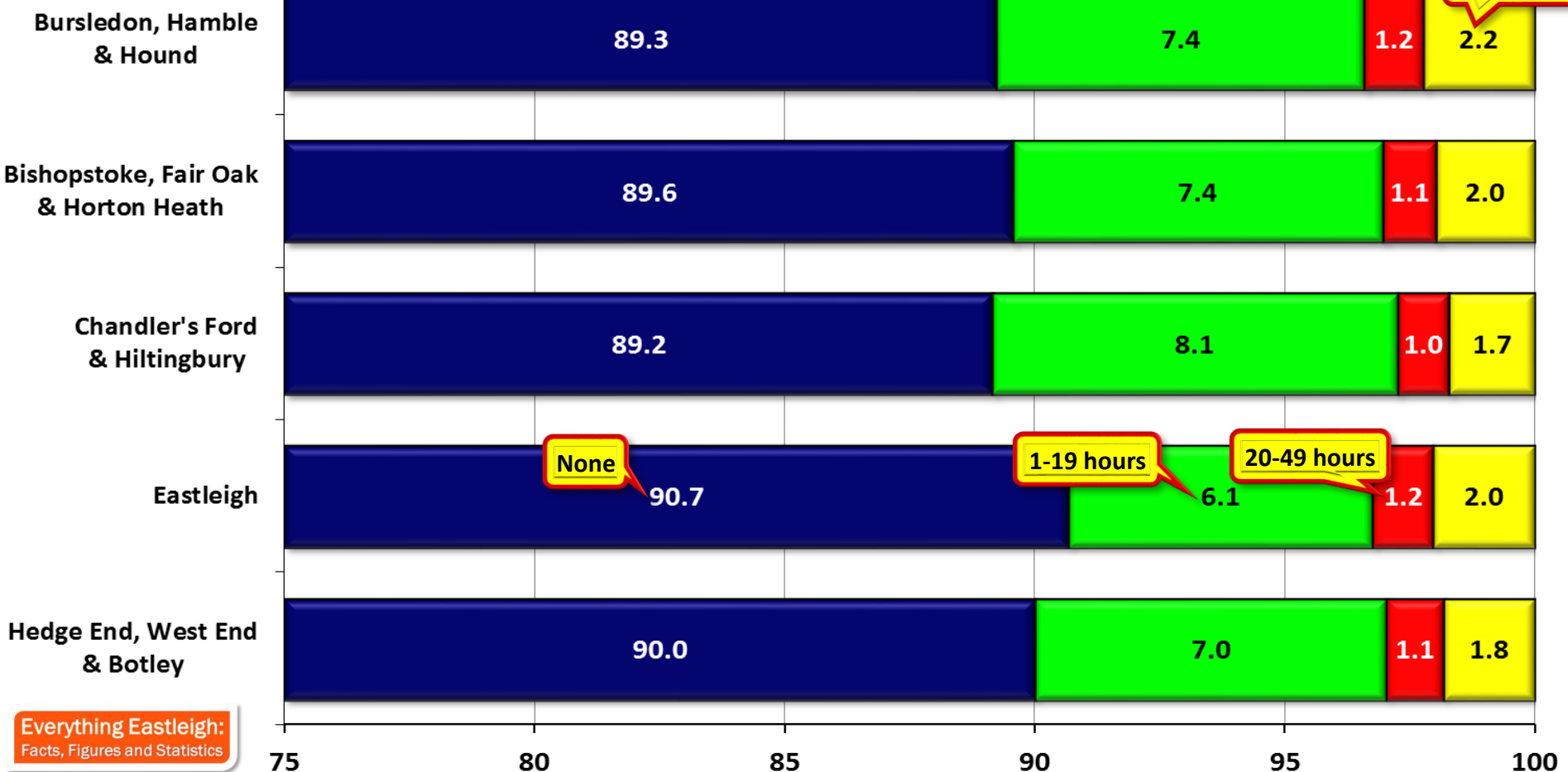

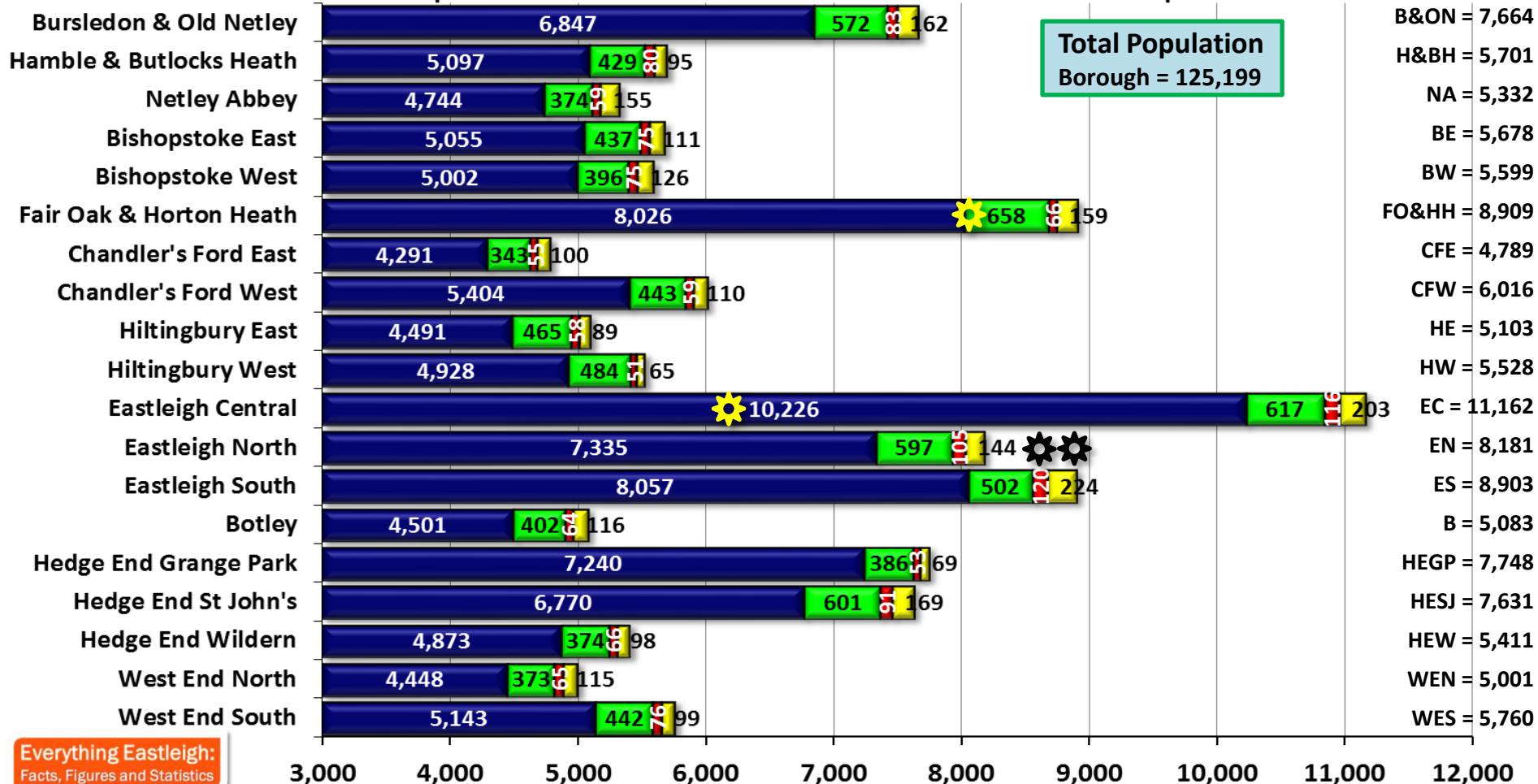
